





Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) are a crucial pillar of India's economy, and Gujarat has emerged as one of the leading states in promoting and supporting this sector. To strengthen the MSME ecosystem, the Government of Gujarat has implemented various subsidy schemes and incentivebased policies aimed at encouraging entrepreneurship, enhancing competitiveness, and promoting sustainable industrial growth. These schemes provide financial support in areas such as capital investment, interest subsidy, technology upgradation, quality certification, and market development. With its industry-friendly approach, Gujarat continues to be at the forefront of MSME promotion. This article presents an overview of the key subsidies and incentives available to MSMEs in the state.

Scheme Name: Amtanirbhar Gujarat Scheme of assistance to MSMEs

Operative period: 5th October 2022 to 04th October 2027

Scheme 1: Capital investment subsidy: Eligible units: Micro Manufacturing Units only Eligible amount of subsidy:

Category of Taluka	Eligible Subsidy	Max. Amt of Incentive
Category 1	25% of term loan	Rs. 35.00/- Lakhs
Category 2	20% of term loan	Rs. 30.00/- Lakhs

Scheme 2: Interest Subsidy:

Eligible Units: Micro / Small / Medium units – Manufacturing enterprises & select service sectors.

Category of Taluka	Eligible subsidy	Max. Amt of Incentive	Period of subsidy
Category 1	Interest subsidy at 7% of term loan	Rs. 35.00/- Lakhs per annum	7 Years
Category 2	Interest subsidy at 6% of term loan	Rs. 30.00/- Lakhs	6 Years
Category 3 & Municipal Corporation Areas	Interest subsidy at 5% of term loan	Rs. 25.00/- Lakhs	5 Years

Also: 1% additional interest subsidy to differently abled entrepreneur, Women entrepreneur, registered start up in manufacturing sector.

Also: 1% additional interest to young entrepreneur below 35 years of age on date of sanction term loan.

Key Points:

- 1. Enterprise will have to bear minimum 2% interest of term loan levied by bank / financial institution.
- 2. If enterprise is eligible for interest subsidy from Govt. of India, the interest subsidy from state will be limited to the extent that enterprise bears minimum 2% interest after availing subsidy from Govt. of India.

An existing enterprise which installs new solar power plant or any other renewal power plant for captive consumption in the premises will be eligible for interest

Scheme 3: Net SGST reimbursement:

Eligible Units: Micro / Small / Medium units – Manufacturing enterprises.

Category of Taluka	Eligible	Max. Amt of Incentive	Period of subsidy
Category 1	100% of Net SGST	7.5% of eFCI per annum	10 years
Category 2	90% of Net SGST	6.5% of eFCI per annum	10 years
Category 3 & Municipal Corporation Areas	Period of subsidy	Rs. 25.00/- Lakhs	5 Years

Period of 10 years will commence from date of commercial production.

Financial support to MSMEs in ZED (Zero Effect & Zero Defect) certification

50%

50% of all charges on the amount after deducting the assistance received from Govt. of India for ZED certification, upto maximum Rs. 50,000/- for operative period of this scheme.

Assistance for patent registration

75%

75% of cost incurred for any number of patent applications, subject to maximum of Rs. 25.00/-Lakhs per applicant / enterprise during operative period of this scheme.

Assistance in implementation of Information and communication technology

65%

65% of capital expenditure related to ICT facilities, upto maximum of Rs. 5.00/- Lakhs for operative period of this scheme.

Assistance for saving in consumption of energy and water

75%

75% of cost of water / energy audit conducted by a recognized consultant / institution subject to maximum of Rs. 50,000/-

25% of cost of equipment recommended by auditing authority subject to maximum of Rs. 20.00/- Lakhs – one time assistance during operative period of this scheme.





Understanding the new bank nomination amendment

The recently proposed amendment now allows you to have 4 nominations in your bank.

What was the previous rule?

Bank accounts (savings/fixed deposits/recurring deposits): Only 1 nominee allowed.

Problems with previous rules: Single nominee

- Assets couldn't be transferred if the nominee predeceased the account holder.
- Legal delays arose without a secondary nominee or will.
- Unclaimed assets were transferred to DEAF* after 10 years.
- Caused family disputes and confusion.

What does the amendment say?

Bank accounts: Up to 4 nominees, with 2 options:

Joint nomination: Assign specific ratio (example, 50% to wife, 30% to son, 20% to daughter).

Successive nomination: Assets pass to the next nominee if the previous nominee is deceased (example, wife → son → daughter).



Need for uniform nomination rules

Current issue: Different formats across financial assets.

Asset	Nominees allowed
MF	8 8 3
Demat	3
Insurance	3
Bank	88884

Solution:

- Standardize nominations across all products.
- Uniform rules will streamline inheritance and asset transfer to heirs.

*DEAF: Depositor Education and Awareness Fund

CASE STUDY

Previous rule

Mr. A has a bank account with 1 nominee (his son). Mr. A passes away, but his son passed away years earlier. The bank cannot release funds easily, causing legal disputes and delays for the family.

New rule: Mr. A appoints 3 nominees: his wife, son and daughter.

Option 1:

Successive nomination:

If Mr. A passes away, the wife inherits 100% of the assets.

If the wife is not alive, the son inherits. If both are deceased, the daughter inherits.


Option 2:

Joint nomination:

Assets are divided as per the specified ratio: Wife (50%), son (25%), daughter (25%)

If a nominee dies, his or her share will be redistributed according to the applicable ratios.





KEY TAKEAWAY

- 04 Nominee could be registered.
- Nominee could be assigned specific ratio.
- Asset could be transferred in hierarchy wise.
- Will reduce legal delays.


