

Evolving Financial Landscape for MSMEs from FY 2025-26

01st April 2025 will mark the opening of new financial year 2025-26 in a different manner. The Government have announced few changes impacting classification of unit as MSMEs and also made changes to the CGTMSE Scheme offering collateral free credit to the business.

The Government of India has revised the criteria for classifying Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSMEs). The investment Limit have been increased by 2.5 times, and turnover limit have been doubled. The revised classification is as under:

Type of Enterprise	Capital Investment		Turnover	
	Current	Revised	Current	Revised
Micro	1	1.5	5	10
Small	10	25	50	100
Medium	50	125	250	500

Key Impacts of the Revised Classification:

1. Impact on Gujarat Government Subsidies:

Subsidies: The expansion of the 'Micro' category will allow more enterprises to qualify for capital subsidies under the Atmanirbhar Gujarat Scheme 2022, fostering local business growth.

2. Implications under the Income Tax Act:

Act: With more enterprises falling under the 'Micro' and 'Small' categories, compliance with Section 43B(h) concerning disallowances becomes crucial.

3. Commercial Impact:

The increased investment and turnover thresholds enable enterprises to invest more in plant and machinery without losing their MSME status, promoting modernization and expansion.

4. Overall Economic Impact:

Higher investments in plant and machinery are expected to boost employment and consumption, stimulating economic growth.

Apart from this, the Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) has made a major announcement regarding the guarantee cover and annual guarantee fees:

Guarantee cover enhanced from ₹5 Cr to ₹10 Cr – improving access to collateral free credit to business.

Reduced annual guarantee fees (AGF) – lowering borrowing costs and improving cash flow for MSMEs. The revised rates of AGF are as per below

Borrowing Slab	AGF %
Rs. 0 – Rs. 10 L	0.37 %
Rs. 10 L - Rs. 50 L	0.55 %
Rs. 50 L - Rs. 100 L	0.60 %
Rs. 100 L - Rs. 200 L	0.85 %
Rs. 200 L - Rs. 500 L	1.00 %
Rs. 500 L - Rs. 800 L	1.10 %
Rs. 800 L - Rs. 1000 L	1.20 %

These revisions aim to provide MSMEs with greater flexibility and support, encouraging their contribution to the economy.



Lecture on - Audit under CBS Environment by CA Kutnal Shah


